Thank you to everyone who came and joined our bring and buy plant sale, it was a very successful event again, raising nearly £490, thanks to all those who brought plants, whether they could come or not, and those who came to buy and support us so generously.

We have had a request from a researcher at University College London (UCL) currently working on a study funded by Cancer Research UK. The study aims to develop a simple educational leaflet that could increase public awareness of gynaecological cancer symptoms and overcome worries about visiting the GP with symptoms.

She is looking for 8-10 women aged between 50 and 70 years to take part in a group discussion about gynaecological cancer and an educational leaflet that is being developed. The focus group will last approximately one hour and will take place at UCL at the end of June or in July (depending on when participants are available). All participants will be reimbursed £20 for travel costs and their time.

To qualify for participation, women must have not been diagnosed with gynaecological cancer and have no health or cancer related qualifications (e.g. doctor, nurse). If anyone is willing to take part let me know and I will send you the details - I shall be doing it as well.

After the walk we will stop for refreshments at the tea shop. Those who wish can visit the house (£10.50) self guided visit or can do more walking or go home.


Social Tea Dance, 19th Sept, 17th Oct & 21st Nov at CANE, New Eltham Library, Southwood Road, 2-4pm.
